Voter Eligibility

To be eligible to vote, you must be:

- at least 18 years of age;
- a United States citizen;
- a resident of the District for at least 30 days immediately prior to the vote.

Voter Verification System

Voting inspectors will confirm a voter's eligibility by checking Erie County voter registration records. If you are eligible to vote in a school election but are not a registered voter, you may sign an affidavit attesting to your eligibility to vote.

Absentee Ballots

Eligible voters who cannot get to the polls on the day of the vote due to illness or travel outside the county may use an absentee ballot. Applications for absentee ballots applications are available online or may be picked up at the District Office, 9625 Main Street, during normal business hours. Call 407-9013 for more information.

Directions to Polling Place

Enter the High School back parking lot from Gunnvilleville Road near the tennis courts. Proceed to the far end of the lot and park in the designated area near the football field. Attendants will direct you to the appropriate building entrance. School officials caution that traffic may be particularly heavy from 3:30 PM when high school students are dismissed up to 9 PM when the polls close.
